US-30 Temporarily Closing Overnight in Kearney Area

Weather permitting, US-30 from Airport Road to Antelope Avenue in Kearney will be closed to thru traffic for two nights, Monday, April 27, and Tuesday, April 28, from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., according to the Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR).

The closures will allow for the setting of new bridge concrete girders that will span US-30 as part of the new Kearney East Bypass construction project. Thru traffic will be detoured westbound at Airport Road, north to 39th, west to Antelope Avenue, and back south to US-30. Eastbound traffic will be detoured north at Antelope Avenue to 39th, east to Airport Road, and back south to US-30. Local traffic needing to access businesses and industry from US-30 inside the defined detour route will be allowed. NDOR personnel will be stationed at Antelope Avenue and Airport Road to monitor traffic during the closure.

Werner Construction, Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, is the prime contractor for the \$26.4 million project. The NDOR manager is Tom Farber of Kearney. Motorists are urged to use caution while driving through highway work zones.
