Bridge Work to Begin on N-22 West of North Loup

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of October 12 on the North Loup West Bridge on N-22 in Valley County, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

M.E. Collins Contracting Company, Inc., of Wahoo, Nebraska, has the \$309,875 contract. Work includes patching and sealing the deck.

The bridge will remain open to traffic during construction, but will be reduced to one-lane traffic using yield signs and barrier curb. The width limit for the bridge will be reduced to 10 feet. Completion of the project is anticipated by mid-November.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Jerry Woodgate of St. Paul. Motorists are reminded to read and adhere to construction signs and to drive cautiously through construction zones.
