Construction Project Begins on N-136 West of Deshler

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of October 19 on N-136, west of Deshler, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

M.E. Collins Contracting Company, Inc. of Wahoo, Nebraska has the \$179,921 project, which consists of culvert, grading, traffic control, seeding and erosion control work. During construction of this 1.2-mile project, traffic will be maintained with flaggers. Motorists can expect reduced speed and one lane work zones. The highway improvement project is anticipated to be completed in early December.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Bob Wiebelhaus. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones at all times.
