NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

S-2-6(1034) 10th St – Old Cheney, Lincoln; C.N. 13284

This Resurfacing and Rehabilitation project will repair and resurface approximately 4.36 miles of Nebraska Highway 2 (N-2) located within the corporate limits of the City of Lincoln in Lancaster County. The project will begin just south of the intersection of N-2 with Van Dorn Street at mile marker (MM) 457+94, and extend southeast to MM 462+31, about 0.11 mile east of the intersection of N-2 with 56th Street.

The purpose of the project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for the project is based on the condition of the roadway.

The improvements on N-2 will consist of concrete repair and milling and resurfacing the roadway and surfaced shoulders with asphalt. The decks on bridges at MM 460+92 and MM 461+91 will be milled and repaired and resurfaced with asphalt. Concrete rails will be sealed. Curb ramps will be constructed at locations requiring repair or replacement. Permanent pavement markings will be applied to all new surfacing.

The project will not require the acquisition of additional property rights. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin spring of 2016 with completion by the fall of the same year. Construction will be completed in segments during non-peak hours. Non-peak hours will be from 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM, Monday night through Saturday morning and from 6:00 AM Saturday morning through 6:00 AM Monday morning. The project will be constructed under traffic during Saturday and Sunday non-peak hours, with lane closures controlled with approved temporary traffic control. Segment work will


require detouring N-2 traffic during Monday through Friday non-peak hours, during which time only a single segment will be closed. A designated detour will be provided for N-2 through traffic, utilizing Interstate 80, U.S. Highway 6, and South 84th Street. Peak hours will be from 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday through Friday, at which time all through lanes, turn lanes, shoulders, and major cross streets will be open to traffic. Major cross streets include 14th Street, 27th Street, 33rd Street, 40th Street, 48th Street, and 56th Street. In addition to peak hours, traffic accommodations will also be made to have all lanes open to traffic on University of Nebraska football home game days and certain holidays.
