
Agency Overview – November 2015

CORE FUNCTION: Plan, develop, construct, operate, maintain, and protect the highway facilities of the state


PAVEMENT and BRIDGES:

There are 9,902 miles on the state highway system




11% of Nebraska roadways are owned by the State

There are 3,520 state-owned bridges




23% of Nebraska bridges are owned by the State

There are 19.8 billion vehicle miles traveled every year




64% of the miles traveled are on State owned roadways


PAVEMENT and BRIDGE PERFORMANCE:
