NW 48th Street Temporary Closure in Lincoln

Weather permitting, on the evenings of Tuesday, December 8 and Wednesday, December 9, NW 48th Street will be closed starting at 9:00 p.m., from the intersection of NW 48th Street and West "O" Street to West Holdrege, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Westbound I-80 traffic wanting to head south on NW 48th Street will be detoured at US-77 south (Exit 397) to the West "O" Street exit and then west on "O" Street. Eastbound I-80 traffic wanting to head north will be routed on Matzke Hwy (Exit 382) and then east on US-34.

Detours will be removed and traffic will resume by 6:00 a.m. the following mornings. The closure is to allow for the existing I-80 eastbound bridge removal over NW 48th Street. The contractor for this work is Hawkins Construction Co., of Omaha, Nebraska. In the event of bad weather conditions, this schedule will be revised.

The Department of Roads' manager is Joe Kuehn. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones, along detours and selected alternate routes.
