New Flashing Yellow Arrow in Columbus

On December 4, the Nebraska Department of Roads installed new left turn signal heads at the intersection of the East 6th and 23rd Streets, Highway 30, in Columbus. The signals have a new flashing yellow section. After the green arrow, a flashing yellow arrow will turn to solid yellow before turning red.

Drivers are advised that they should yield to oncoming traffic when facing a flashing yellow arrow as they make a left turn.
