Work to Begin on US-73 in the Verdon Area

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of February 1 on US-73 from Reference Post 11+00 to Reference Post 16+50 east and west of Verdon, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Hawkins Construction Company, of Omaha, Nebraska, has the contract for the \$4,039,000 project, which consists of guardrail replacement, bridge rail replacement, concrete bridge deck repair and membrane waterproofing. During construction, traffic will be controlled by traffic signal lights and “reduced speed” signs with a 14-foot width restriction. Minimal delays can be expected. The project is anticipated to be complete in August 2016.

The Department of Roads’ project manager for this project is Ron Klaus of Fairbury. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through the construction work zones.
