## NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

### STPD-89-3(106) Stamford East & West; C.N. 70838

Identified as *Stamford East & West*, the proposed 3R (Resurfacing, Restoration and Rehabilitation) project would resurface approximately 6.50 miles of Nebraska Highway 89 (N-89) located in Furnas and Harlan counties.

The proposed project would begin approximately 600 feet east of the Nebraska Highway 46 (N-46) and N-89 junction, at mile marker (MM) 52+23, and would extend to MM 58+73, about 0.83 mile west of the Republican River. A portion of the project is located within the Village of Stamford's corporate limits. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 200 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of this project is to preserve the N-89 transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the condition of the roadway and bridges.

Additional improvements would include work on four bridges. Three of the bridges (Structure Numbers S089 05267, S089 05367, and S089 05581) would be replaced with culverts. The fourth bridge (Structure Number S089 05737) would receive a new guardrail, bridge rail, and deck repairs.

This project would not require the acquisition of additional property rights. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction, but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. Impacts to wetlands are anticipated.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin spring of 2016 with completion by the summer of 2017. Bridge work would be completed in 2016, and the asphalt paving would be completed in 2017.

The proposed project would be constructed under traffic; however, the bridge replacement at MM 55+83 would require an approximate 75-day closure of County Road C where it intersects with N-89. A designated detour would be provided for C Road traffic, utilizing 711 Road and either Niobrara Avenue in Stamford to the West, or D Road to the East.

NDOR understands that roadway construction may cause temporary inconvenience and hardships, but we are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system. With your help we can achieve this goal.
