

# NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF ROADS NOTICE OF HIGHWAY PUBLIC MEETING

The Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) will hold a public information open house regarding a proposed improvement of Nebraska Link 55W (L-55W) in Lancaster County. The meeting will be held at Nebraska Department of Roads, Central Headquarters - Auditorium, 1500 Highway 2 in Lincoln, on Tues., February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 5:00 - 7:00 P.M.

Identified as *Warlick Blvd., US-77 – N-2, Lincoln*, the proposed project would repair, resurface, and replace approximately 2.24 miles of L-55W located within the corporate limits of the City of Lincoln.

The purpose of this proposed project is to preserve the L-55W transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the current condition of the roadway.

The planned construction would consist of concrete pavement repairs, concrete surface milling, resurfacing, pavement removal, placement of doweled concrete pavement and concrete pavement, trimming the existing subgrade, rebuilding the surfaced median, repairing four bridges, and repair and/or replacement of damaged curb inlet lids. Additional improvements would include curb ramps, guardrail, culvert work, and offset of the left-turn lanes at Creekside Trail.

This project would not require the acquisition of additional property rights. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction, but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. No environmental impacts are anticipated.

The project would be constructed in two phases. The first phase of construction would last the entire 2017 year. Phase 2 construction would last the entire 2018 year. A portion of the proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled with approved temporary traffic control; however, the proposed project would require detouring a segment of South 14<sup>th</sup> Street

traffic. A designated detour would be provided, utilizing U.S. Highway 77 (US-77), Van Dorn Street, and Nebraska Highway 2 (N-2). Details will be available at the public meeting.

This public open house meeting is being held to provide information regarding the proposed project, currently in the design phase, and to receive the public's input. All interested persons are invited to attend and present relevant comments and questions. Design information will be displayed and personnel from NDOR will be present to answer questions and receive comments. The information "open house" format allows the public to come at any time during the advertised hours, gather pertinent information about the project, speak one-on-one with project personnel and leave as they wish.

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
