Information Open House Feb. 23 for Improvements on Nebraska Link 55W in Lincoln

The Nebraska Department of Roads will hold an Information Open House February 23 regarding the proposed improvement of Nebraska Link 55W (L-55W) in Lancaster County, known as **Warlick Blvd., US-77 – N-2, Lincoln**. The open house will be held from 5:00-7:00 p.m. at the Nebraska Department of Roads Central Headquarters Auditorium, 1500 Highway 2, in Lincoln.

The proposed project would repair, resurface, and replace approximately 2.24 miles of L-55W located within the corporate limits of the City of Lincoln. The planned construction would include repairing four bridges and the repair and/or replacement of damaged curb inlet lids. Additional improvements would include curb ramps, guardrail, culverts, and offset of the left turn lanes at Creekside Trail.

A portion of the proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures; however, the proposed project would require detouring a segment of South 14th Street traffic. Details will be available at the public meeting.

The project would be constructed in two phases. The first phase of construction would last the entire 2017 year. Phase 2 construction would last the entire 2018 year.

Personnel from the Department of Roads will be available to answer questions, receive comments, and discuss any aspect of the proposed highway improvement project.
