Information Open House March 8 for Improvements on US-6 in Hastings Area

The Nebraska Department of Roads will hold an Information Open House March 8 regarding the proposed improvement of U.S. Highway 6 (US-6), in Adams County, known as **Hastings Southeast**. The open house will be held from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Hastings City Hall, 220 N. Hastings Ave., in Hastings.

The proposed project would begin about 0.77 mile east of the junction of US-6 and U.S. Highway 281/U.S. Highway 34, in Hastings, and would extend east to about 0.94 mile east of the eastern corporate limits. The project would remove and replace the existing pavement, which would accommodate additional traffic lanes. The project would also include storm sewer, sidewalks, curb ramps, culverts, lighting, traffic signals and permanent pavement markings.

A portion of the proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures; however, the urban portion of the project would require detouring US-6 through traffic. Details will be available at the public meeting.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin on this Build Nebraska Act project in the spring of 2018 with completion by the summer of 2020.

Personnel from the Department of Roads will be available to answer questions, receive comments, and discuss any aspect of the proposed highway improvement project. 
