

NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF ROADS NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

NH-77-3(127) In Oakland and South; C.N. 31951

Identified as *In Oakland and South*, the proposed project would resurface or reconstruct approximately 6.56 miles of U.S. Highway 77 (US-77) located in Burt County.

The proposed project would begin at about the Dodge-Burt county line, at mile marker (MM) 135+24, and extend north to MM 142+20, in Oakland. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 200 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of this project is to preserve the US-77 transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the condition of the roadway and bridges.

Additional improvements would include the replacement of two bridges over the Logan Creek Tributary (Structure Numbers S077 13643 and S077 14011), removal and replacement of guardrail, shoulder work, removal and replacement of existing inlets (4th Street and US-77), culvert work, and curb ramp construction within the corporate limits of Oakland.

This proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights, including new right-of-way (ROW), and temporary easements (TE). Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction, but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. Impacts to wetlands are not anticipated.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin spring of 2017 with completion by the summer of 2018. Bridge and culvert work would be completed in 2017, and the asphalt paving would be completed in 2018.


The proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled with approved temporary traffic control.
