## Work to Begin on N-66 near Ashland

Weather permitting, construction work is scheduled to begin the week of March 21 on N-66 at the I-80 Mahoney Interchange (Exit 426), between Reference Post 100+82 and Reference Post 101+55, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Tab Holding Company, Inc., DBA Tab Construction of Omaha, Nebraska, has the \$3,474,595 contract for grading, culverts, bridge repairs, concrete pavement, guardrail and seeding.

During the bridge repair work, traffic will be restricted to one lane with a maximum width of 11 feet, and will be controlled with temporary traffic signals. All other work will be performed utilizing daily lane closures and flaggers. Work is anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2016.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Bob Traudt of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
