Work to Begin on N-92 East of Archer

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of March 28 on N-92 east of Archer, beginning at Reference Post 360+45 and ending at Reference Post 372+18, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Vontz Paving, Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$5,836,827 contract for the 14-mile project. Work includes bridge replacement and repair, box culverts, guardrail, roadway widening, milling, asphalt overlay and shoulder work.

N-92 will be closed to through traffic and a detour will be in place for the duration of the project. The detour will direct traffic north on US-281 out of St. Paul to N-22, then east to N-14, south on N-14 and back to N-92. The project is anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2016.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Jerry Grooms of York. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones, along detours and selected alternate routes.
