## Work to Begin on N-2, Lincoln to Syracuse

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of March 28 on N-2, Lincoln to Syracuse, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Western Engineering Company, Inc. of North Platte, Nebraska, has the \$4,931,836 contract for milling and asphalt resurfacing of both inside and outside shoulders for westbound and eastbound lanes. Work will also include milling and resurfacing of ramps on N-43 and N-50 interchanges.

During construction traffic will be maintained in one lane. The project is anticipated to be completed by September.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Dewaine Knutson of Lincoln. Motorists are urged to use caution when driving through construction zones.
