Bridge Work to Begin on N-44 in Kearney

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of April 18 on the North Platte River bridges located between Talmadge Street and 4th Street on N-44 in Kearney, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Iowa Erosion Control, Inc. of Victor, Iowa, has the \$379,812 contract. Work includes repairing the expansion joints and abutments. This work will require lane closures throughout the duration of the project with one lane of traffic maintained each direction through the project. The anticipated completion date is mid-July.

The Department of Roads' manager is Kent Washington of Kearney. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
