Roundabout Construction to Begin at N-10 and N-40 Intersection

Weather permitting, as part of the Phase III construction of the Kearney East Bypass, preliminary work will begin the week of April 11 on the roundabout at the intersection of N-10 and N-40 north of Kearney, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Temporary lane closures will be in place during removal of the raised concrete median and pavement, followed by placement of temporary asphalt surfacing at the southwest corner of the intersection. Preliminary work should be completed the week of April 18.

Once the temporary surfacing is completed, northbound traffic will be shifted to head-to-head in the southbound lanes, and roundabout construction will begin on the east side of the intersection. Existing 78th Street east of the intersection will be closed during construction.

Motorists can access Dawson Public Power's facility from the east on the newly constructed concrete pavement and new access road. Local access will be maintained from Avenue "N" west on the new concrete roadway. Anticipated completion for construction of the new roundabout is early September.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Tom Farber of Kearney. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction work zones.
