## Work to Begin on I-180 in Lincoln Area

Weather permitting, construction work is scheduled to begin the week of April 18 on I-180 between Fletcher Avenue and Adams Street, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska, has the \$2,367,000 contract, which includes concrete pavement repair, removing and replacing two inches of asphaltic concrete, and rumble strip installation. The work will take place between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Motorists can expect single-lane closures on both northbound and southbound lanes of I-180 during that timeframe.

Ramp closures are possible at two interchanges located within the project limits, the I-80 interchange and the Superior Street interchange, between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Motorists are encouraged to use Cornhusker Highway and the Airport Interchange or Cornhusker Highway and 27<sup>th</sup> Street for access to I-80 and Superior Street during the time of the ramp closures. The project is anticipated to be finished in early July.

The Department of Roads' manager is Bob Sanburn of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
