Temporary Lane Closures on I-180 – Updated Information

Weather permitting, temporary lane closures will occur Friday night at 7:00 p.m., April 22 on I-180 in the northbound lanes between Cornhusker Highway and Fletcher Avenue, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

The contractor will be doing some concrete pavement repair. The following ramps and loops will also be closed as part of the repair work:

- The ramp from Superior Street to northbound I-180
- Exit 401B (loop from eastbound I-80 to northbound I-180 and US-34)
- Ramp from westbound I-80 to westbound US-34 at Exit 401

The exit to 9th street and downtown Lincoln will remain open.

From I-80, motorists are advised to use Exit 399 and follow Cornhusker Highway to I-180 for access to I-180/US-34 north. Traffic from Superior Street should go to Cornhusker Highway and then to I-180/US-34 north.

It is anticipated that all the closed lanes, ramps and loops will be open to traffic around early afternoon on Saturday, April 23.

The Department of Roads' manager is Bob Sanburn of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
