Work to Begin on N-10, Pleasanton to Hazard

Weather permitting, construction work is scheduled to begin the week of May 16 on N-10 between Pleasanton and Hazard, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Werner Construction Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$678,408 contract for milling, patching and applying a thin lift asphalt overlay. The goal of the thin lift technique is to reduce the cost and construction time needed to provide a new driving surface.

Traffic will be maintained with lane closures controlled by a flagger and pilot car throughout the duration of the project. Completion of the project is anticipated in early June.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Eric Klein of Grand Island.

Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
