Work to Resume on N-66 near Ashland

Weather permitting, bridge repairs and road construction work is scheduled to resume the week of May 31 on N-66 at the I-80 Mahoney Interchange (Exit 426), between Reference Post 100+82 and Reference Post 101+55, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Tab Holding Company, Inc., DBA Tab Construction of Omaha, Nebraska, has the \$3,474,595 contract for grading, culverts, bridge repairs, concrete pavement, guardrail and seeding.

During the bridge repair work, traffic will be restricted to one lane with a maximum width of 11 feet, and will be controlled with temporary traffic signals.

N-66 rehabilitation work will include the construction of temporary surfacing and lane shifts in order to accommodate the removal and replacement of the existing concrete pavement, utilizing daily lane closures and flaggers. Work is anticipated to be completed in the fall.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Bob Traudt of Lincoln. Motorists can expect daily delays and are urged to use US-6 as an alternate route to the local attractions.
