## Work Progressing on N-2, 10<sup>th</sup> St. to Old Cheney Rd., Lincoln

Weather permitting, Constructors, Inc., of Lincoln, Nebraska, plans to move in to segment two of six beginning Wednesday, May 25 at 7:00 p.m., according to the Nebraska Department of Roads. With this progression in to segment two, N-2 will be closed from the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection of 27<sup>th</sup> Street, both eastbound and westbound, from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday night through Friday night, with single lane closures on weekends.

The through traffic detour will remain the same with the use of I-80, US-6, and 84<sup>th</sup> Street. The local traffic detour will be Van Dorn Street, US-77, Warlick Blvd., Old Cheney Rd. and 27<sup>th</sup> Street. Lane closures will also be in place 24 hours a day for bridge rehabilitation eastbound and westbound between 48<sup>th</sup> Street and 56<sup>th</sup> Street.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Brian Schoen of Lincoln. Motorists are asked to drive safely and use caution while driving through construction zones. Motorists are also being reminded to watch for changing conditions as the work continues to progress.
