Work to Begin on US-136, Filley to Crab Orchard

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of May 30 on US-136, Filley to Crab Orchard, from Reference Post 187.11 to Reference Post 196.48, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Knife River Corporation, DBA Knife River Midwest of Sioux City, Iowa, has the \$3,506,172 contract to construct new asphalt surfacing and to remodel bridge surfaces. Traffic on this 9.4-mile project will be controlled by one-lane work zones, along with temporary traffic signals. The project is expected to be completed in the fall.

The Department of Roads' Project Manager is Russell Eltiste of Tecumseh. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
