

Weather permitting, starting at 6:00 AM Saturday, June 18th, the following exits at the I-80/I-180 interchange will be closed to allow the Department of Roads' contractor to perform shoulder restoration and final cleanup work as part of the I-180 overlay project. The westbound I-80 Exit 401 will be closed. This closure will affect the I-80 to Highway 34 West exit ramp and the I-80 to I-180 South exit loop. Exit 401C, the northbound I-180 to I-80 West exit loop, will be closed. Exit 401B, the eastbound I-80 to Highway 34 West exit loop, will be closed. It is anticipated that these ramps and loops will reopen before 12:00 PM. From I-80, people are advised to use Exit 399 and follow Cornhusker Highway to I-180 for access to I-180 and Highway 34. Northbound I-180 traffic should use Cornhusker Highway for access to I-80 West.

Single lane closures and shoulder closures may also be encountered on I-180 between Fletcher Avenue and Cornhusker Highway, at the I-180 / Superior Street Interchange and also at the remaining open ramps and loop at the I-180 / I-80 Interchange as part of the project's final clean-up work.
