Work to Begin on N-4, Plymouth to Beatrice

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of June 27 on N-4 from Plymouth to Beatrice, Reference Post 144+03 to Reference Post 156+12, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors, Inc., of Lincoln, Nebraska, has the contract for the \$2,040,994 project, which includes asphaltic concrete overlay work. During construction, traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists can expect delays and an alternate route is recommended. The project is anticipated to be completed in the fall.

The Department of Roads' project manager for this project is Ron Klaus of Fairbury. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
