Temporary Closures on I-80/I-180 Ramps in Lincoln

Weather permitting, starting at 6:00 am Saturday, June 25, the following exits at the I-80/I-180 Interchange will be closed to allow the contractor for the I-180 overlay project to perform final clean-up work, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors Inc., of Lincoln, Nebraska is the contractor for this \$2.367 million asphaltic concrete overlay project.

The ramp from southbound I-180 to I-80 west at Exit 401 will be closed. The ramp from northbound I-180 to I-80 east at Exit 401D will be closed. The loop from northbound I-180 to I-80 west at Exit 401 C will be closed. The loop from eastbound I-80 to US-34 west at Exit 401B will be closed. The exit from westbound I-80 that allows access to the ramp for Highway 34 west and the loop that connects to I-180 south leading to downtown Lincoln will be closed. Shoulder cleanup work will be performed under traffic maintained conditions on the remaining open ramps at the I-180/I-80 Interchange and at the I-180/Superior Street Interchange. Lane closures in the northbound and southbound lanes of I-180 between Fletcher Avenue and Cornhusker Highway may also be encountered.

It is anticipated that these ramps and loops will reopen as clean-up work progresses. From I-80, motorists are advised to use Exit 399 and follow Cornhusker Highway east for access to I-180 and US-34. I-180 and Superior Street traffic should use Cornhusker Highway to either North 27th Street or the Airport Interchange for access to I-80.

The Department of Roads' manager for this highway improvement project is Bob Sanburn. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through the construction zone.
