Work to Begin on N-67 North of N-62 in Shubert Area

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin on N-67 in the Shubert area the week of July 11, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

The project starts on N-67 at the junction with N-62, working north to just south of the Little Nemaha River. The project also includes work on Spur 64E into Indian Cave State Park, beginning at the junction with N-67 and ending at the entrance to Indian Cave State Park.

Knife River Corporation DBA Knife River Midwest of Sioux City, Iowa, has the \$2,354,828 contract. Work includes milling and resurfacing the existing roadway with asphaltic concrete and replacing cable guardrail.

Traffic on N-67 and Spur 64E will be controlled by one-lane work zones, using a pilot car and flaggers. The project is anticipated to be completed in the fall.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Bill Jasa of Tecumseh. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
