Temporary Intersection Closures at 33rd, 40th, and 48th on N-2 in Lincoln

Weather permitting, Constructors, Inc., of Lincoln, Nebraska, plans to close the intersections of 40th Street and N-2 and 48th Street and N-2 in all directions, and have northbound and southbound lane restrictions at 33rd Street and N-2 on Thursday, July 21, and Friday, July 22, at 7:00 p.m. The intersections will be closed until 6:00 a.m. the following morning, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

The closures are to allow for the milling and placement of asphalt in the area intersections. All other intersections will remain open. Eastbound and westbound N-2 will be closed from 27th Street to Old Cheney Rd. from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Traffic will be detoured around the closures via Pioneers Blvd. for traffic north of N-2 and Old Cheney Road for traffic south of N-2.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Brian Schoen of Lincoln. Motorists are asked to watch for detour signage and, as always, drive safely through construction zones.
