Work to Begin on N-8 West of Salem

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin on N-8 west of Salem the week of August 17, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

The project starts on N-8 at the junction with N-50 north of Dubois, working east to Salem. Knife River Corporation DBA Knife River Midwest of Sioux City, Iowa, has the \$1,349,615 contract, which includes milling and resurfacing the existing roadway with asphaltic concrete.

Traffic on N-8 will be controlled by one-lane work zones, using a pilot car and flaggers. The project is anticipated to be completed by late summer.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Bill Jasa of Tecumseh. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
