Work to Begin on N-105 South of Humboldt

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin on N-105 south of Humboldt on Friday August 12, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

The project starts on N-105 at the junction with N-8, working north to Humboldt. Knife River Corporation DBA Knife River Midwest of Sioux City, Iowa, has the \$568,502 contract, which includes milling and resurfacing the existing roadway with asphaltic concrete.

Traffic on N-105 will be controlled by one-lane work zones, using a pilot car and flaggers. The project is anticipated to be completed in late summer.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Bill Jasa of Tecumseh. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
