## Work to Begin on N-14 South of Aurora

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of August 29 on N-14, beginning at the east junction of US-6 north to Aurora. Work will include bridge repair and culvert work, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Vontz Paving, Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$5,755,194 contract for the 15.9-mile project. Traffic will be maintained with lane closures at the four bridge locations and two culvert locations using temporary traffic control signs. County Road 321 will be temporarily closed with a marked detour to repair a culvert at the intersection of County Road 321 and N-14. There will be a 12-foot width restriction during construction.

N-14 will be reopened to traffic by late November. The remainder of the work, including grading and asphalt overlay, will be resumed and completed in the spring of 2017.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Kevin Kohmetscher of Hastings. Motorists are reminded to drive safely through work zones.
