Maintenance Work on US-6 Near Pleasant Dale

August 30, 2016 (Lincoln, Neb.) — Weather permitting, a chip seal project will begin September 1 on US-6 near Pleasant Dale, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads. Chip seal is an application of an asphalt binder to a roadway surface followed by an aggregate.

State maintenance forces will be doing a chip seal from Reference Post 302 to Reference Post 306 north of Pleasant Dale starting at the junction of US-2/N-103 east of the roundabout and then east for three miles. The work is anticipated to take one day. One-lane traffic will occur with the use of a pilot vehicle and flaggers. The speed limit through this area will be reduced to 55 mph. Motorists should expect to see delays and are reminded to drive cautiously through highway work zones.
