

NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF ROADS NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

RD-112-1(1005) E. Jct N-8 – US-77; C.N. 12978

Identified as *E. JCT N-8 – US-77*, the proposed 3R (Resurfacing, Restoration and Rehabilitation) project would resurface approximately 6.50 miles of Nebraska Highway 112 (N-112) located in Gage county.

The proposed project would begin at the east junction of N-112 and Nebraska Highway 8 (N-8), at about mile marker (MM) 9.10, and extend north to MM 15.60, approximately 0.12 miles south of the junction of N-112 and U.S. Highway 77 (US-77), where the pavement changes from asphalt to concrete. This project would also resurface the entire length of Nebraska Link 34H (L-34H), from MM 0.00 to MM 0.60, and repair two bridges (Big Indian Creek Bridge; Structure Number S112 01122 & Sicily Creek Bridge; Structure Number S112 01283) located in Gage County. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 200 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of this project is to preserve the N-112 and L-34H transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the condition of the roadways and bridges.

Proposed improvements would consist of milling and resurfacing the existing roadways, and bridge repairs that would include partial depth deck repairs, asphalt resurfacing with membrane, repairing of steel and timber piles, and sealing of concrete rails. Additional work would include guardrail work, culvert work, and curb and flume installation.

This project would require the acquisition of additional property rights including new right-of-

way (ROW) and temporary easements (TE) for construction throughout the project area. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction, but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. Impacts to wetlands are anticipated.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin spring of 2017 with completion by the fall of 2017.


The proposed project would require detouring N-112 traffic; a designated detour would be provided, utilizing N-8, US-77, and L-34H.
