### New Highway and Street Superintendents Licensed

November 8, 2016 (Lincoln, Neb.) — Four people successfully completed the October 7, 2016 examination and are now licensed by the Board of Examiners for County Highway and City Street Superintendents.

Licensed as City Street Superintendent is Mr. James T. Traylor, 3<sup>rd</sup> of Omaha.

Licensed as County Highway Superintendents are Mr. Steven Baird of Gering; Ms. Terri Malek-Madani of Lincoln; and Ms. Georgia Stockley of Seward.

Baird is Equipment Operator for the Scotts Bluff County Road Department; Malek-Madani is Training Coordinator, University of Nebraska LTAP; Stockley is Administrative Assistant for the Seward County Road Department; and Traylor is Street Crew Leader, City of Gretna.

Superintendents are qualified to administer city and county street and road programs, including:

- ◆ preparing one- and six-year improvement plans,
- ◆ assisting in preparing annual budgets and financial reports,
- ◆ supervising the annual program for roadway design, construction and maintenance, and
- ◆ coordinating plans with adjacent counties and cities and with the Nebraska Department of Roads.
