Information Open House December 1 for Proposed Improvements on US-385 in Dalton

November 17 2016 (Lincoln, Neb.) — The Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) will hold an information open house December 1 regarding proposed improvements of U.S. Highway 385 (US-385) in Cheyenne County, known as **In Dalton**. The open house will be held from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Dalton Senior Center, 224 Main Street, in Dalton.

The proposed project would reconstruct approximately 0.39 miles of the existing pavement on US-385, starting at the intersection of US-385 and Wano Street, at mile marker (MM) 52+01, and extending north to approximately 300 feet north of State Street, at MM 52+40. The planned construction would include removing the existing asphalt pavement and constructing new concrete pavement and other miscellaneous items.

As a result of the proposed project, potential impacts are anticipated at North Park, located at the northwest corner of US-385 and State Street. Temporary easements for curb ramp construction would be required. A gravel driveway would be relocated.

Construction could begin as early as spring of 2018 and be complete by the fall of the same year. Details will be available at the meeting.

Personnel from the Department of Roads will be available to answer questions, receive comments, and discuss any aspect of the proposed highway improvement project.
