
2018 NEBRASKA Safety Belt Facts

- ✓ In Nebraska, 230 people died and 17,726 were injured in traffic crashes in 2018.
- ✓ In Nebraska, one collision occurs every 15 minutes.
- ✓ Forty-nine persons were injured each day in motor vehicle crashes and one person was killed every 38 hours.
- ✓ Of the 230 traffic fatalities, 175 (76%) were occupants of passenger vehicles.
- ✓ Of the 175 traffic fatalities, 39 (22%) were rollovers.
- ✓ Of the 175 traffic fatalities, only 59 (34%) were wearing safety belts; 116 (66%) were not wearing safety belts.
- ✓ Of the 116 (66%) **not** wearing safety belts, 35 (30%) **were** thrown from the vehicle.
- ✓ Motor vehicle crashes cost Nebraska over \$5,526,133,400 in 2018 utilizing the 2015 National Safety Council calculable costs of motor vehicle crashes.
- ✓ Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death among those ages 5-24.
- ✓ The observed safety belt use rate in 2018 for drivers and passengers was 85.5%.
- ✓ Safety belts **when used** reduce the risk of fatal injury to front-seat passenger car occupants by 45% and light truck occupants by 60%.
