ITEM 1

Annual Weights & Measures Inspections

FUEL SYSTEMS

To maintain a safe fueling area, we recommend that your fuel system is current on inspections, labels are in good condition, and fire extinguishers are in good working order. These items are discussed below:

ITEM 1: The fuel system shall be inspected annually by an inspector from Weights & Measures in the Nebraska Department of Agriculture (NDoA)



NDA-inspected gas pumps receive a **Weights & Measures approval sticker** with the inspection year clearly marked. The sticker signifies the device is functioning correctly and the customer may expect a fair transaction.

Your airport should be registered and on the NDoA schedule. Please coordinate with us on schedules and completion of inspections. Contact Scott Arner at Weights & Measures (402.471.3422) with questions regarding inspection schedules.

ITEM 2: Signage and labels identifying the contents of the tanks and safety warning signs need to be in good legible condition. Cracked, peeling, or missing signs and labels should be replaced prior to the airport safety inspection.

ITEM 3: Fire extinguishers shall be inspected annually by a certified inspector prior to the airport safety inspection. Class BC fire extinguishers are for aviation use, not the general purpose Class ABC ones found

at your local hardware store. At a minimum, a fire extinguisher shall be placed within reach from the fuel dispenser and near the emergency shutoff switch.

IN ADDITION, we recommend making sure your Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) document is current and readily available in the event of a spill. For more information go to the EPA website: Oil Spills Prevention and Preparedness Regulations | US EPA
