

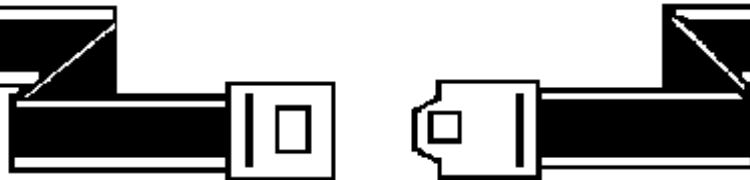
2017 NEBRASKA TEEN DRIVER FACTS

Teen drivers ages 19 & younger represent 7.3% of all licensed drivers in Nebraska; includes all Learner's Permits (LPD), School Permits (SCP), and Provisional Operator's Permits (POP).

In 2017, 72.7% of the 22 teen traffic fatalities (drivers and passengers, ages 13 -19) were NOT wearing seat belts.

TEEN DRIVERS (Ages 19 & Younger) WERE INVOLVED IN:

- 21% of all reported crashes
- 20% of crashes between **9 p.m. and midnight**
- 15% of crashes between **midnight and 3 a.m.**
- 23% of crashes using a **cell phone**
- 37% of **"exceeding the speed limit"** crashes
- 17% of **"failure to yield"** crashes
- 24% of all single-vehicle **rollover** crashes
- 22% of crashes due to **"road conditions"** which were wet and/or snowy
- 26% of **"speed too fast for conditions"** crashes
- 26% of **rear-end type** collisions
- 11% of **alcohol-involved** crashes
