



Public show of support essential for Heartland Expressway corridor plan

t's on us now. Following the completion of the Kimball Expressway, the state's \$88 million investment in the Panhandle, we need to push for the link to South Dakota and beyond.

The original expressway plan for Nebraska called for Scottsbluff-Gering (and other cities of similar size) to be connected to Interstate 80, which is Nebraska's transportation lifeline. The Heartland Expressway was an extension of that vision, calling for an expressway linking Colorado and South Dakota through the Panhandle. The larger vision, which has taken fire to the north and south of us, is to link agricultural and energy markets from Canada to Mexico through the central United States commonly referred to as the Ports-to-Plains Expressway. The Kimball link completes one phase of that vision, but it's far from the last.

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Tonight from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Civic Center in Gering, we'll get our first look at the proposed route and the environmental study results of the expansion of the Heartland Expressway north from Scotts Bluff County to the South Dakota border. The Nebraska Department of Roads officials and consultants will be waiting there for you and your information.

The NDOR is imploring citizens to come forward and contribute to the discussion of the route, funding, environmental impact, costs and benefits and how the corridor is to be financed. They want to know what economic development is currently under way and what resources we have that could be leveraged if the road goes in.

This meeting is not about what NDOR can do for us. It's about what we can do for ourselves and the rest of Nebraska. We have to sell the road to the NDOR, because its officials have to sell it to others.

If you can remember back to when the state proposed the expressway system in Nebraska, the primary purpose was to generate jobs and a higher standard of living for the people who live in western Nebraska.

With the wind energy boom and the discovery of oil reserves in Canada and North Dakota, the expressway project has gained higher visibility. Industries supporting oil and gas exploration, in particular, need supporting infrastructure.

NDOR Project Manager Randy ElDorado and consultants are looking to us for support and for information, practical knowledge about our economy, our environment, our plans and our vision.

It's our chance to listen and offer advice. We need to be there.

Heartland Expressway project seeking input, support

Longtime supporters say the completion of a Heartland Expressway depends on the public's support of the project.

A Thursday afternoon meeting in Gering will provide a sneak peek into the expressway's next stage. To gauge support, and provide up-to-date information on its progress, Nebraska Department of Roads officials and consultants will host an open house to gather input from local residents 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Civic Center in Gering.

Randy ElDorado, planning and location studies engineer for NDOR, said people can expect a lot of information at the meeting about where the project stands. The NDOR is already looking at

projected traffic numbers extending out to 2025.

"We are inventorying our findings on the presence of environmental resources such as wetlands and threatened and endangered species," ElDorado said. "We are preparing an analysis of costs to complete the corridor which includes all remaining expressway segments to Colorado, Wyoming and South Dakota borders." ElDorado said the NDOR is coordinating with the other states involved to find out timetables for projects inside those borders, as it is important for planning purposes. ElDorado hopes for a big turnout by the public, to gather ideas and understand the level of support in the west for the completion of the project.

"We need to display what we've done and the information we've gathered," ElDorado said. "We need to hear from them and get the public's input. We are primarily out there to gain knowledge via public input."

The NDOR is also completing and updating economic benefits of a completed expressway corridor, but that information will not be completed by Thursday.

"We've spent a lot of money on the completed part of the corridor. What do we expect to happen from an economic development impact if we complete this corridor?" El-Dorado asked. "What are developing impacts and the total investment? We don't know exactly what the costs are for completing the remaining segments."

ElDorado said a big part of NDOR's economic forecast will focus on the potential of Canadian and Mexican energy development, since the Heartland Expressway is part of the Ports-to-Plains Corridor connecting all three countries.

ElDorado hopes that people in the area will come in droves and be ready to talk and offer opinions about the route or need for the Heartland Expressway. Consultants Alfred Benesch Company and AECOMM will also be in attendance to listen to concerns and opinions of the public to-

ward the project.

"We'd like people to be ready to talk about what segments we should focus on first in the completion of the expressway. What sections do they perceive of as dangerous? What do they see as busy with high traffic volumes? What growth potential do they see in Western Nebraska regarding wind energy or wind energy development?"

ElDorado also wants local information on any environmental information such as wells, established deer crossings, wetlands or any other environmental issues of which the local population might have special knowledge.

But mostly, ElDorado says the NDOR needs to gauge the support for the project.

"We need to know if they are in support or not for a project like this," ElDorado said. "It is going to take a lot of support from the region."

ElDorado said the NDOR wants to put all the finances, benefits and social, political and environmental impediments together to form a current snapshot of the process.

"We want to engage the public and learn what they know," EIDorado said. "If we have a good meeting I'll be completely exhausted, because people would have come by and shared with us. We'll have done a lot of talking and listening."

The meeting will be from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. this Thursday at the Civic Center in Gering.






One important example includes new industrial development such as the oil and gas exploration and production of the Niobrara formation is expected to add travel to Nebraska Roads



Key ideas emerging from the study so far focus on the intended character of overall improvements to the corridor and forecasts of travel demand by 2035.

The Heartland Expressway Steering Committee has agreed to pursue the following long-term improvement concepts:

- Evaluate roadway facility type to meet regional travel demands
- Evaluation of bypass warrants for local communities
- Upgrading of at-grade rail crossings; and
- Consideration of other major safety improvements.




Other preliminary ideas emerging from the work at this point include identification of the factors expected to increase travel demand within the State of Nebraska by the Year 2035.

While population and economic growth have been limited since 2000, various factors reflect the potential for considerable growth by the Year 2035.


Roadway capacity, safety and other facility improvements in Nebraska is anticipated to cause more travel through Nebraska than would be expected otherwise.

This figure shows travel demand growth by the Year 2035. The blue numbers represent locations that would experience an increase up to 99% over the Year 2010 travel demand, the purple numbers represent areas that would experience a growth of 100 to 199%, while the locations shown in green represent areas that will experience a 200% increase or higher over the next 25 years upon completion of Ports to Plains Alliance Corridor and the development of oil and gas industry.



The environmental review will provide:


- A high-level planning study to help guide future environmental documentation under the National Environmental Policy Act or NEPA.
- Details to better understand specific resources and constraints within the corridor and
- a description and evaluation of potential impacts to the natural and human environment.
- Coordination with the Federal Highway Administration, US Fish and Wildlife, US Forest Service, State Historical Society, Nebraska Game and Parks, and other resource agencies regarding important environmental resources



A wide range of natural and human resources are present in the project corridor. Natural resources such rivers and streams and their associated habitats will be protected along with habitats of threatened and endangered species.



Other key resources to be protected include community or human resources such as parks, historic sites, neighborhoods, businesses and air quality, to name a few.



The next steps involve considering public input and then further analysis to develop a Draft Corridor Development and Management Plan for public review. The steps include:

Creating a timetable for completion of all planning and development activities and environmental reviews and permits;


Incorporating the results of environmental reviews;

Development of a complete analysis of corridor costs and benefits;

Creating a finance plan, including alternative financing; and

The identification of any impediments to the development and construction of the corridor, including any possible environmental, social, political, and economic objections.










TONNAGE ON HIGHWAYS, RAILROADS and INLAND WATERWAYS: 2007














TRAFFIC FORECAST SCENARIOS

Existing and Future Baseline Conditions

2010 Existing Traffic:

This scenario serves as the baseline condition and applies existing traffic counts. The baseline condition is compared to the 2035 forecast scenarios to establish anticipated differences attributable to various factors.

2035 without Improvements:

This scenario evaluates 2035 conditions based on traffic counts and growth trends, but does not reflect traffic that may result from making transportation improvements that would draw additional vehicles into the Heartland Expressway Corridor. This scenario is often referred to as the "No Build Alternative"

Future "Build" Conditions

2035 With Heartland Improvements:

This scenario highlights how improvements within the boundaries of the Heartland Expressway Corridor would influence 2035 traffic volumes.

2035 With Heartland Improvements and Niobrara Activity:

This scenario reflects the future importance of transportation increases associated with anticipated natural resource extraction activities involving the Niobrara formation.

2035 With All Great Plains Trade Corridor Improvements:

This scenario highlights how improvements along the entire Great Plains Trade Corridor would influence 2035 traffic volumes without considering impacts of the Niobrara activity. This scenario includes the Heartland Expressway Corridor improvements.

2035 With All Great Plains Trade Corridor Improvements and **Niobrara Activity:**












PERCENT CHANGE IN TRAFFIC FROM 2010 TO 2035 ULTIMATE BUILD









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
