I spoke with Mr. Wally Wallesen on August 28, 2012 concerning the use of the apparent domestic water well located at frontage road 9105+00 (approx.) left (see attachment, Well A). Mr. Wallesen stated that the well is only used periodically and was last used 4-5 years ago. Mr. Wallesen, who owns the well stated that he had no specific plans use the well in future and that decommissioning the well was a possibility he would consider. Mr. Wallesen said they use the water well near Station 9103+00 (approx.) left (see attachment, Well B) on a yearly basis. There is a common power supply to both of the above mentioned wells. Power for wells A&B originate from the back of an old storage building located near mainline project station 1092+00 (approx.) left.

Mr. Wallesen also stated that there is another well located further south that would be associated with the former gasoline filling/service station and grocery store (confirmed by Mr. Wallesen) located near approximate mainline Station 1089+50 left. Mr. Wallesen stated that this well had not been used in over 40 years and was last known to pump sand.
