Purpose and Need

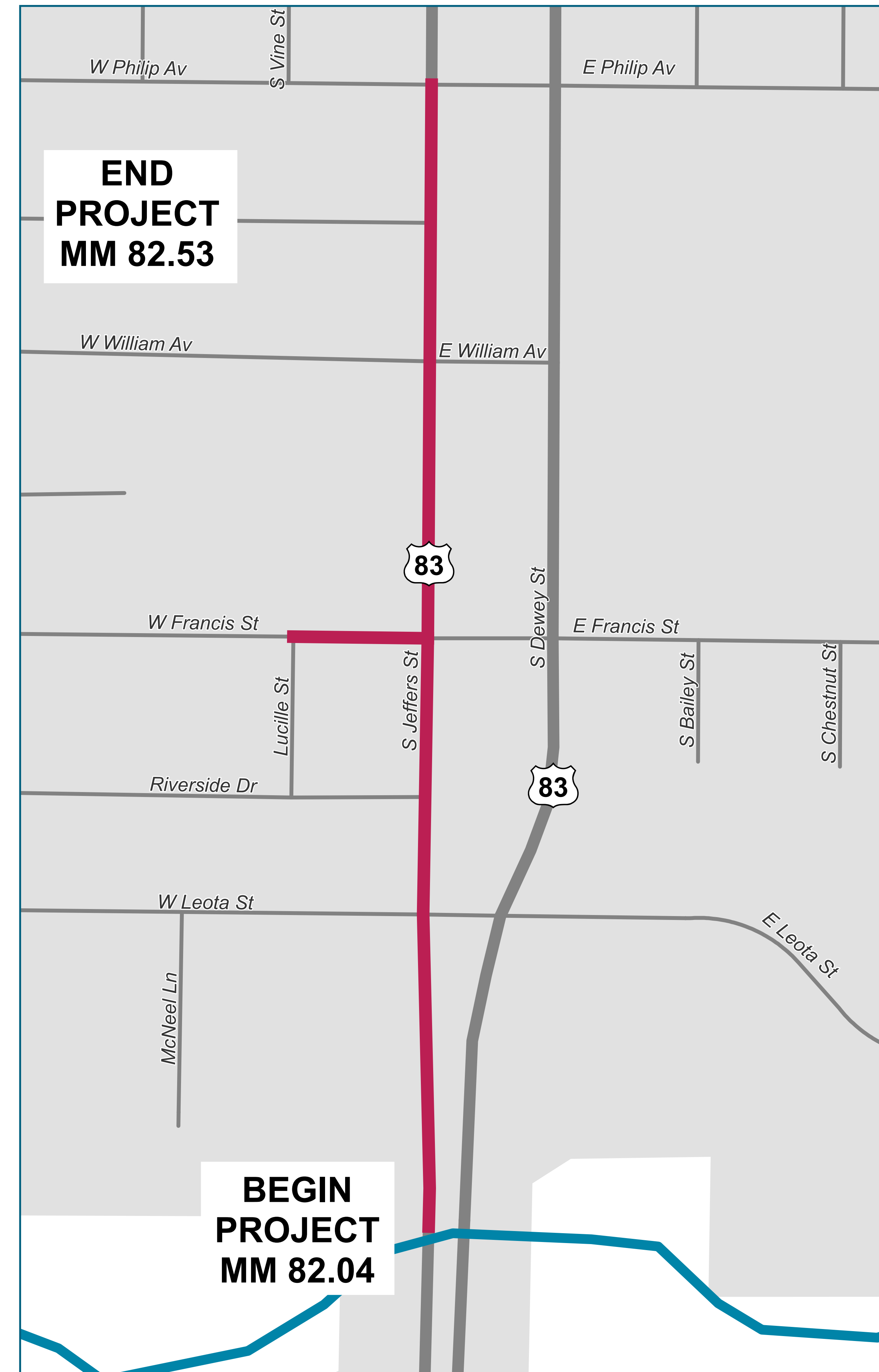
The purpose of these projects is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and ensure the mobility of the traveling public.

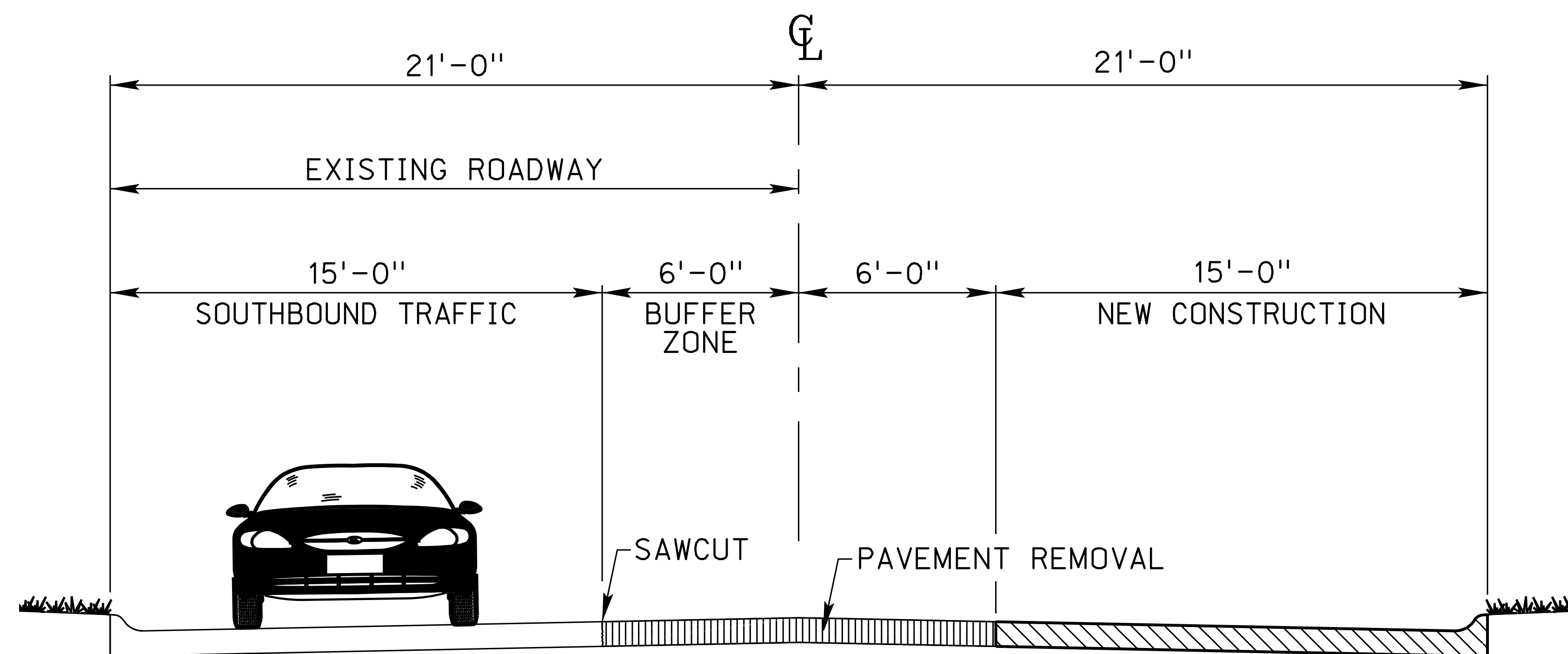
2024-Segment 2 (Philip St-1st St)



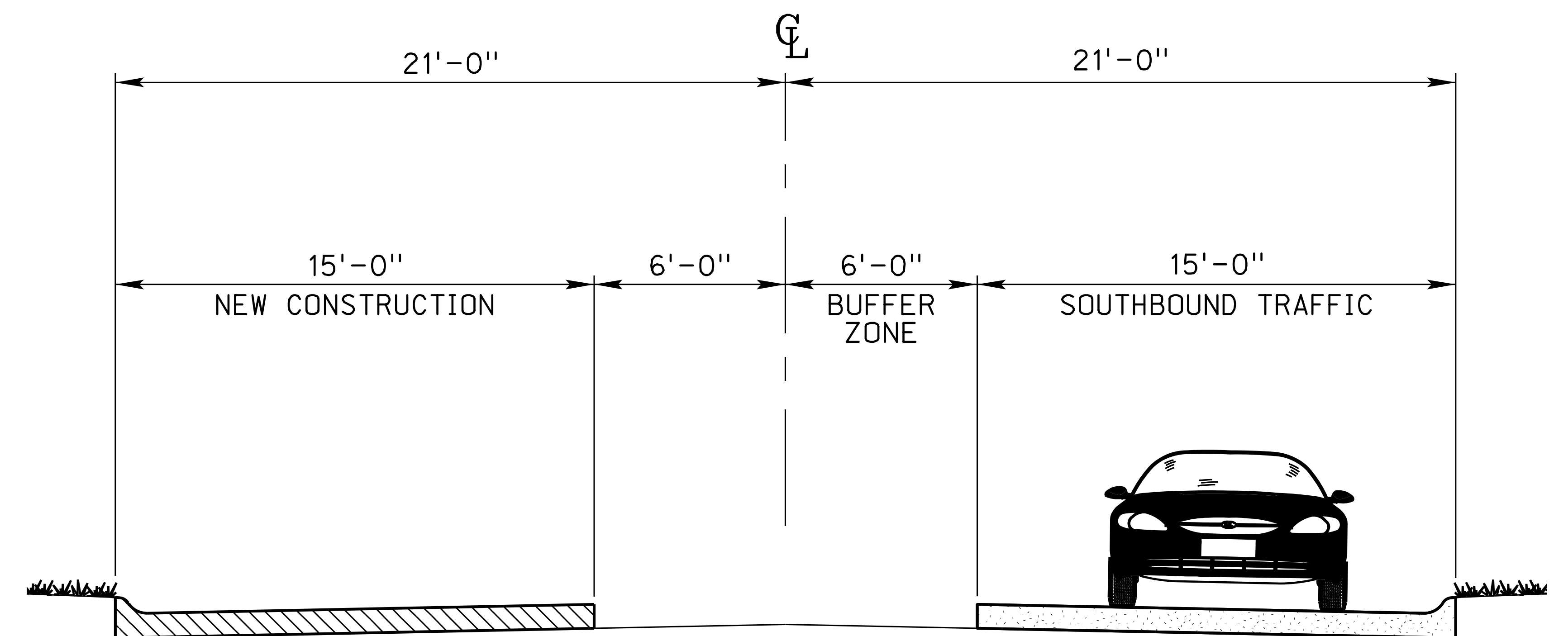


Construction Phasing

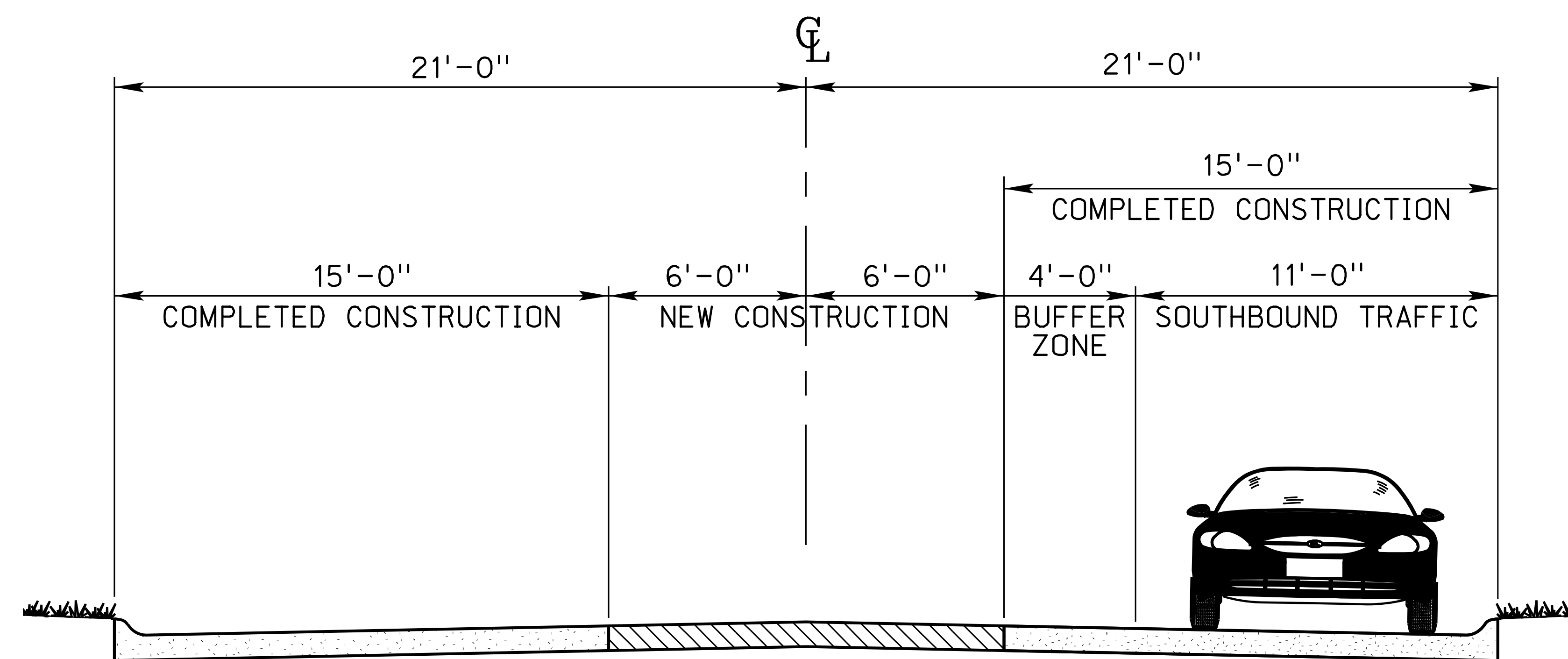

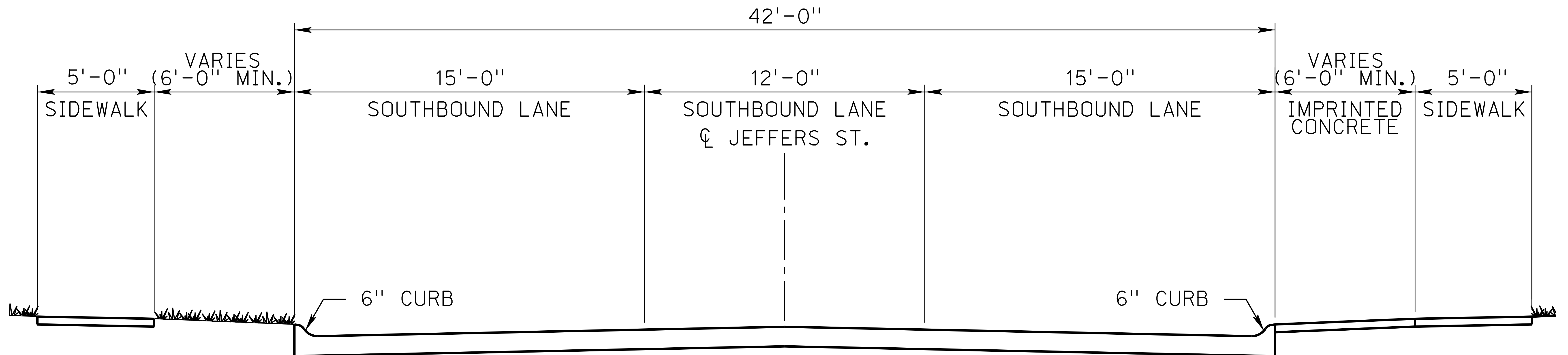

Project Timeline

Weather permitting, construction is tentatively scheduled to begin late May of 2023 and be completed in the winter of 2024.

2023

Segment 1

Leota St - Philip St

Phase 1: Remove center lane pavement and remove and replace east lane of SB US-83

Phase 2: Remove and replace Francis St and west lane of SB US-83

Phase 3: Replace center lane of SB US-83

2024

Segment 2

Philip St - 1st St

Phase 1: Remove center lane pavement and remove and replace east lane of SB US-83

Phase 2: Remove and replace west lane of SB US-83

Phase 3: Replace center lane of SB US-83

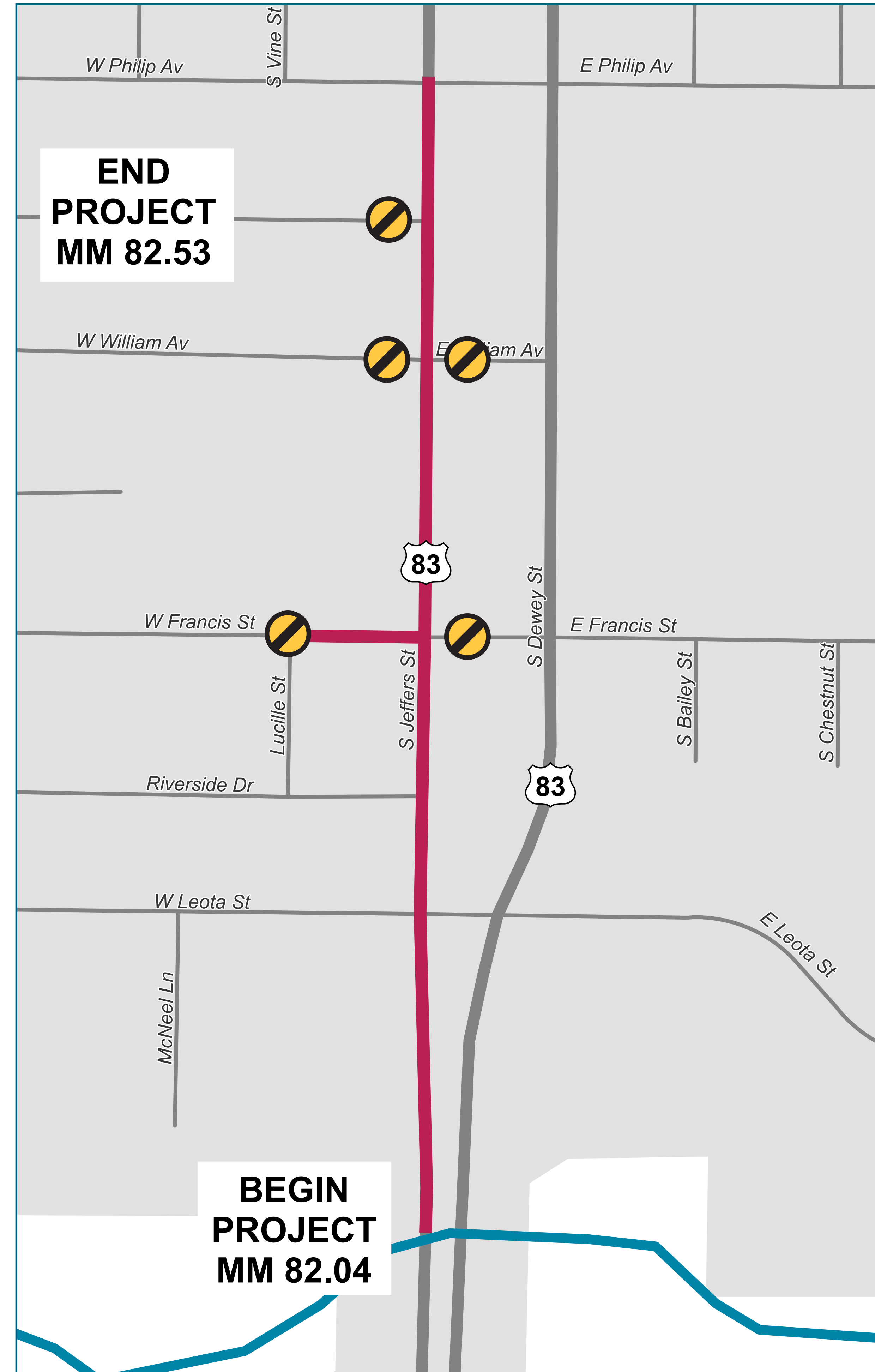


Project Impacts

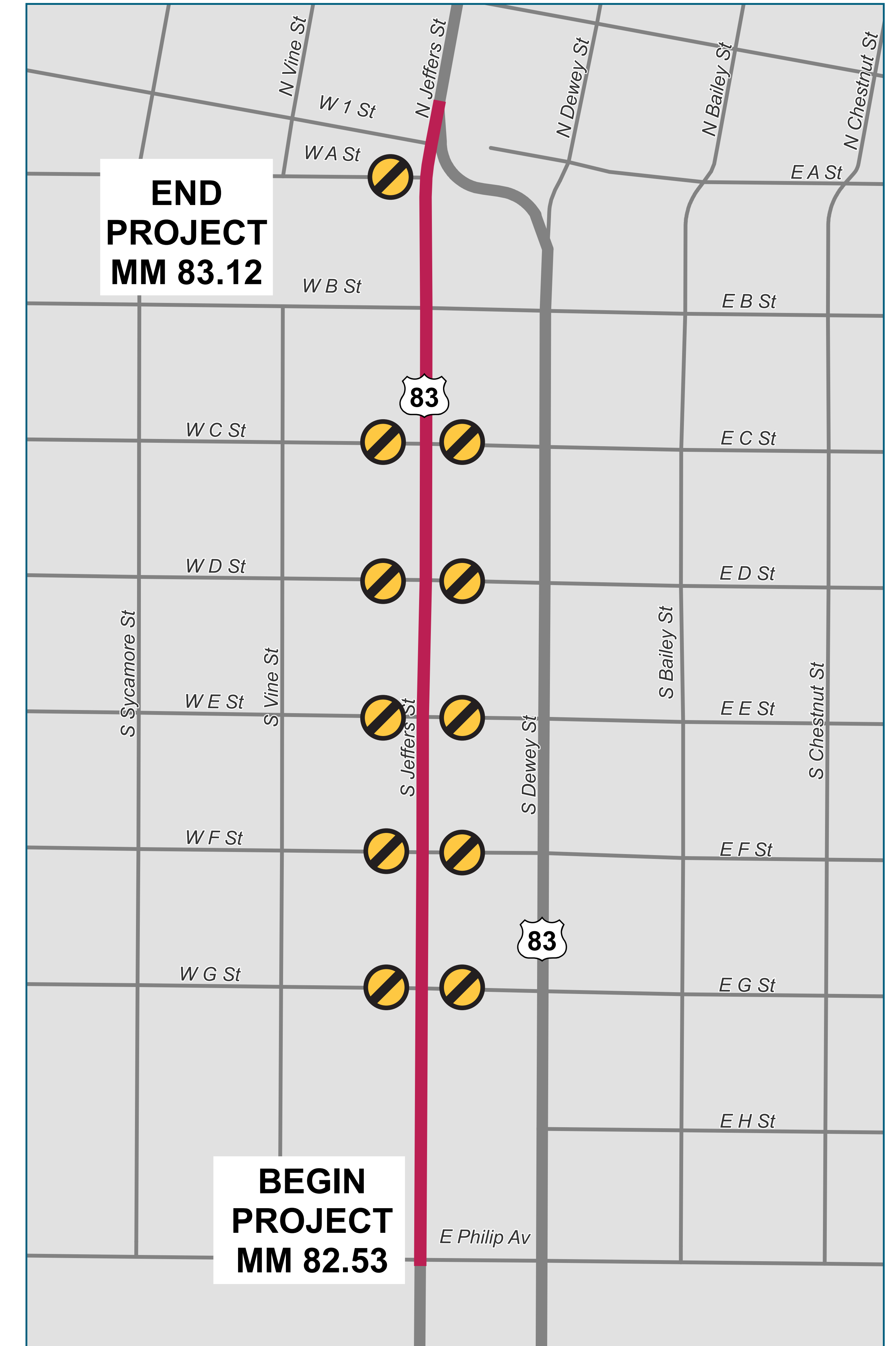
The projects will require **alternating** temporary closures of side streets along US-83.

Night time work will be required and will begin in summer 2023.
